#### OVERVIEW:

Notice is hereby given by the Workers' Compensation Board of BC of its intent to contract with Designer Appliances Inc. for the provision of a site license for Nib Click-less Software.

WorkSafeBC has been using Nib Click-less Software for our employees to reduce strain and stress associated with mouse-usage. Due to the increase usage requirement and deployment to a large number of employees for one of our divisions, WorkSafeBC has selected the Nib Click-less Software site license for this deployment.

WorkSafeBC has chosen not to call for Proposals for the following reasons:

- System compatibility.
- Familiarity with the product.
- No learning curve for installation and support.
- Meet deployment date of August 17, 2009.

The value of this award is approximately fifty thousand (\$50,000) dollars in US funds.
