Notice is hereby given by the Workers' Compensation Board of BC (WorkSafeBC) of its intent to contract with **Schneider Canada Incorporated** for the repair of existing 2000 kVA Transformer on the WorkSafeBC Head Office Richmond location.

Schneider Canada Incorporated will provide the following service:

- Supply and replacement of existing 2000 kVA Transformer Core and Coil

The contract is one time at estimated value of \$164,000.

WorkSafeBC has chosen not to call for Provider qualifications for the following reasons:

- Retrofit of primary components of Transformer can be completed over a shorter time period than full Transformer replacement and as a result during non operating hours.
- The projected cost to replace primary Transformer components is less than full Transformer replacement and related hardware.
- Schneider Canada Inc. owns the existing Transformer patents and turnkey design.

If justified, WorkSafeBC will convene a meeting with its representatives and the supplier to receive supplier representations concerning this contract.

The Supplier's qualifications, being an established provider and the ability to provide the services at the same level of expertise and value, will be key criteria with regard to the consideration of contractor objections.
