Questions & Answers

Question #1

What is the start date and is there an end date for services?

Answer #1

Anticipated start date is as soon as possible. End date is currently not known.

Question #2

How much, approximately, travel do you foresee?

Answer #2

Travel would be minimal and only for attendance at conferences or seminars, as directed.

Question #3

Will WorkSafeBC provide liability insurance (i.e. Community pharmacists are required to carry minimum \$2 million liability insurance) or would I have to provide that for myself?

Answer #3

The Consultant is responsible for arranging and paying for all insurance requirements.

Question #4

Do I need to be incorporated or under sole proprietorship? Or will I be considered an employee of WorkSafeBC?

Answer #4

The Consultant may be either incorporated or a sole proprietorship. The Consultant will not be considered an employee of WorkSafeBC.

Question #5

Can you let me know if this expression of interest is a new consultant position or was someone previously providing this service?

Answer #5

WorkSafeBC is currently under contract with a Pharmacist Consultant, however, in a business area separate from this new requirement. EOI #H007-2009 may therefore be deemed as a new consultant position.
