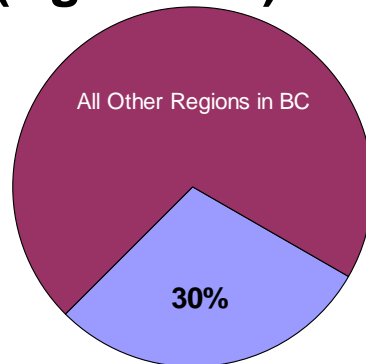
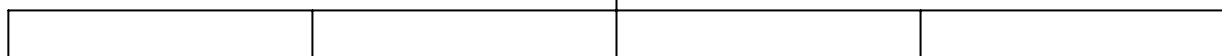


# Greater Vancouver Young Worker (Age 15-24) Claim Hierarchy Tree

**Within the Most Common Accident Types shown above:**

- “Struck By” represents specific accident types that include “Struck by Falling Object” and “Struck by Slipping Handheld Object”, among others.
- “Overexertion” represents specific accident types that include “Overexertion in Lifting” and “Overexertion in Pulling, Pushing Objects”, among others.
- “Fall from Elevation” represents specific accident types that include “Fall/Jump to Lower Level, NEC” and “Fall from Ladder/Steps & Stairs”, among others.

Note: Greater Vancouver includes Vancouver, North Vancouver, Burnaby, New Westminster, Richmond, and Delta.

Subsectors shown above are the top 5 based on a ranking of young worker time-loss claims volume between 2002 and 2006 for the region.

### Young Worker Time-Loss Claims Accepted Between 2002 and 2006 – Greater Vancouver

- In Greater Vancouver, approximately 75% of young worker time-loss claims accepted between 2002 and 2006 relate to males.

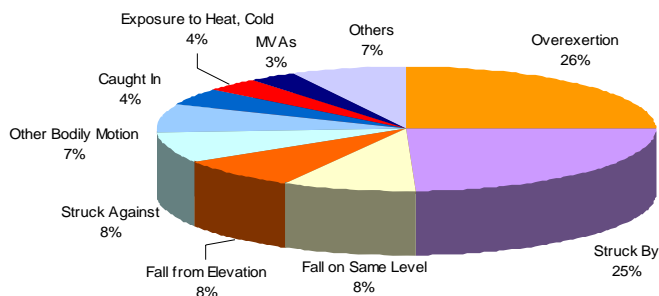

### Young Worker Claim Costs and Days Lost – Greater Vancouver

- Between 2002 and 2006, approximately \$76,345,000 in claim costs were paid relating to young worker claims for Greater Vancouver, regardless of the year of injury.
- Between 2002 and 2006, approximately 343,530 work days were lost for young worker claims in Greater Vancouver, regardless of the year of injury.
