4) clearing away brush and vegetation from industrial areas such as utilities, railroads

and right-of-ways.

- 3) large scale land clearing or excavation work (see CU 721031);
- 4) pool, spa or hot tub installation (see CU 721044);
- 5) park maintenance (see CU 761049);
- 6) highway maintenance (see CU 723002);
- 7) pressure washing roofs (see CU 764022);
- 8) brushing and weeding or tree thinning or spacing related to forestry (see CU 703002);
- 9) falling, delimbing, or removal of entire trees not related to forestry (see CU764062); or
- 10) demossing roofs (see CU 721051 and 721036).
